## Entry Requirements, Admission and Provisional Registration

#### Master of Philosophy (MPhil)

A First or Upper Second Class undergraduate degree in a relevant subject or equivalent qualification in a subject appropriate to that of the programme to be pursued.

### Doctor of Philosophy (PhD)

PhD degree applicants should normally have been awarded both a Master's Degree and a First or Upper Second Class Honours Degree in a relevant subject. They should also have experience in the area of professional practice they wish to research or have satisfied the requirements for transfer from MPhil to PhD.

A student for an MPhil or PhD must register and shall register provisionally pending full registration and shall undertake to comply with statutes, rules and regulations of the University.
